Pole position for rolling start left



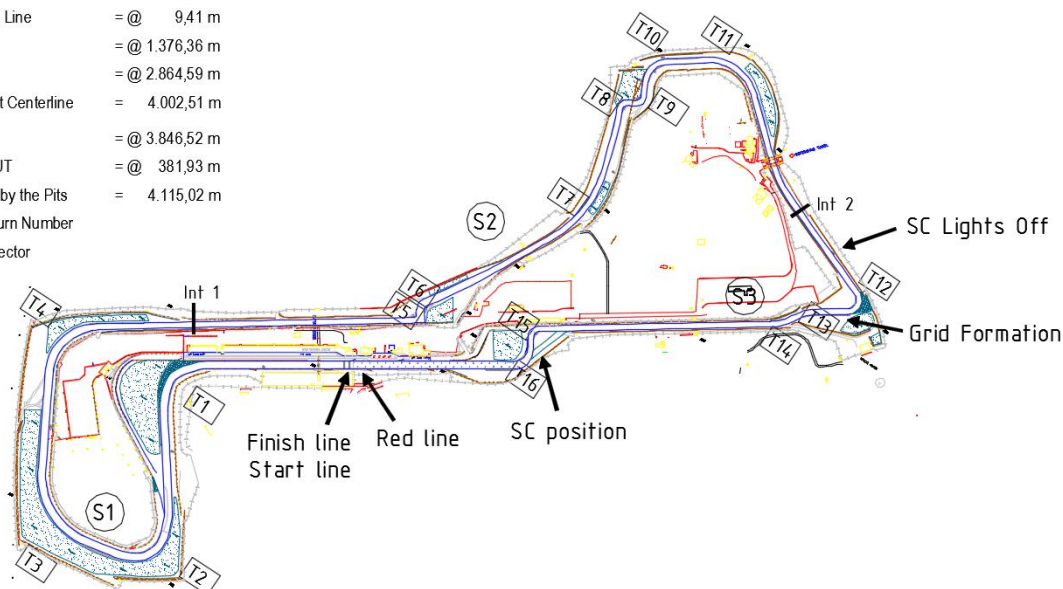
## Track plan Circuit Zolder

## Noise restrictions

No noise limitation:

Thursday 24 August 2023 from 09:00-12:00 and 13:00-24:00

Saturday 26 August from 09:00 to Sunday 27 August 18:00.

Before and after the times from beginning and ending there must be a complete motor silence for all competition vehicles. The motor silence is obliged for every car, each breach will be fined with a penalty going on from € 500,00 to even exclusion from the race meeting if this motor silence isn't respected.

**There is complete motor silence for cars with combustion engines:**

- until 09:00 on Thursday and Saturday
- between 12:00 and 13:00 on Thursday
- after 24:00 on Thursday and 18:00 on Sunday
- Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday **day and night!**

This applies to all race cars, motorbikes, quads and sound equipments.

The organizer is submitted to the regulations on music activities as listed in chapters 4.5,



5.32 and 6.7 of the Flemish Environmental Legislation (VLAREM) and article 561 of the Criminal Code concerning noise at night.

### Passes

50 paddock tickets, 20 pitlane tickets. **Attention: pitlane ticket is only valid for the pitlane and is not an entry ticket! For entering the paddock you need a paddock ticket!** 2 paddock pass for service vehicle, 5 parking passes P Teams, 3 motorhomes parking and 50 gridwalks. May we ask you to clearly mention the recipient (person/ firm) on the envelopes with tickets you leave at the accreditation center/welcome center for your employees or guests.

Teams entered in the 24 Hours of Zolder can buy paddock tickets with a discount of 50% on the ticket price; being Saturday or Sunday € 35,00, Weekend € 50,00.

### Grid walk

All teams and guests must be properly accredited for the grid walk - paddock passes do not grant grid access. Pitlane, grid walk or VIP passes only for teams and guests.

*Note: no under 16 permitted on the grid!*

### Delivery

Cars or vans with "delivery passes" may be used for a maximum of 30 minutes within the paddock for delivery purposes. After this time, they must return to their correct parking area (Parking P Teams). Failure to do so may mean the removal of the car as well as being reported to the Stewards, where a fine can be awarded.

### Paddock

The paddock for the Belcar Endurance Championship is in paddock 2 including garages.

**No earlier entry to the race track and paddock is allowed!**

### **Mobile homes & motorhomes**

All caravans, mobile homes and motorhomes are allowed to park only at the allocated area. All caravans, mobile homes and motorhomes parked in this area must have a designated parking ticket of Circuit Zolder.

Place reservation is not allowed.

### **The setup of tents (or similar) is strictly prohibited.**

Only for teams who have submitted in advance an application to the organization and only for sportive purposes. May **not** be used for **hospitality**.

Application via e-mail must be sent to [larissa@belcarseries.com](mailto:larissa@belcarseries.com) as soon as possible.

With the start of setup the **whole paddock speed limit of 30km per hours** may not be exceeded (except for rescue vehicles in emergency case). Contravention may induce serious penalties up to exclusion of the meeting.

If a vehicle - regardless which kind of vehicle - will not respect the speed limit after its first warning, the parking and access passes will be withdrawn.

Vehicles (race trucks, race services,...) that have to be parked in the paddock must appear optically perfect and totally clean.

### **Catering**

Teams are responsible for their own catering, taking into account the existing exclusivity at Circuit Zolder.

Due to fire safety, it is only permitted to cook and/or to heat food with a heat source in the locations indicated as kitchen, equipped with the necessary fire-fighting installations. All derogations must first be submitted for agreement to the internal safety coordinator of Circuit Zolder.





### Garages/Boxes

At the disposal of the Belcar teams from Tuesday 22 August 2023 - 12:00 till Sunday 27 August 2023. No renting will be charged only a deposit of € 100,00 for the key of the garage/box.

Teams may access the garages from Tuesday 22 August 2023 from 12:00-20:00 and Wednesday 23 August 2023 from 08:30-20:30.

All teams **must share** garages. **3** cars per double garage.

We know that the space at the rear is limited if you are with 3 cars in a double garage that's why if all the trucks do not fit behind your allocated garage(s) these vehicles can be parked close by in paddock 1.

Outside installations must be finished by Wednesday 23 August 2023 at **20:30**.

Pit wall installations may be set up on Tuesday 22 August 2023 from 15:00-20:30 and Wednesday 23 August 2023 from 08:30-20:30.

Various deliveries are authorized: on Tuesday 22 August 2023 from 12:00-**20:00**, on Wednesday 23 August 2023 from 08:30-**20:30**, on Thursday 24 August 2023 from 08:00-**12:00**; on Friday 25 August 2023 from 08:30-**18:00** and on Saturday 26 August 2023 from 08:00-**12:00**.

The area behind the garages is only destined for sportive purposes and therefore it may not be used for hospitality tents or hospitality busses. Any breach will be fined: € 65,00/m<sup>2</sup>.

Each commercial or promotional activity must be submitted to VZW Terlamen for approval in written.

**Garages key collection** will be located in the Controletoren (Offices Maria and Gamze) - ground floor:

Tuesday 22 August 2023 : 12:00-20:00

Wednesday 23 August 2023: 08:30-20:30

Thursday 24 August 2023 : 08:00-20:30

In order to recover the deposit, the key must be brought back on Sunday 27 August **before 19:00!**

Deposit for the key of the garage: € 100,00 per key per garage. Note: **ONLY CASH!**

➔ Installation: On request Tuesday 22 August **12:00-20:30**, Wednesday 23 August **08:30-20:30**

➔ Dismantling: garages must be vacated by Monday 28 August **13:00**.

### **Transponder with driver ID**

For the benefit of timekeeping every car must have a MyLaps transponder with driver ID. Teams not having a MyLaps transponder with driver ID can buy one from Timeservice.NL (info@timeservice.nl)

### **Fuel**

At the fuel station in paddock 4 (with credit cards) and during the **night qualifying** and the **race** at the “refueling zone” (this is the place in the pitlane where the fuel pumps are located).

### **Refuelling during the 24 Hours of Zolder**

For the use of fuel during the 24 Hours of Zolder 2023 an advance of € 2.750 must be paid by bank transfer before Monday 21 August 2023, with reference : “24 Hours 2023 - Fuel - race number x”.

The final settlement will be made in the week following the race.

### **Refuelling modalities** (supplementary regulations)

A team member must refuel the car. In the refuelling area, any vehicle that wishes to refuel must be attended by maximum two team members in addition to the driver.

It is only allowed to refuel the maximum amount indicated in article 22.1.3 of the Belcar Endurance Championship Sporting regulations 2023. It is the responsibility of the team member to control that the refuelled amount is not more than allowed.







The team (driver and team members) is responsible for the safe refuelling operation and the safe release.

In case of the refuelling area is facing a malfunction of any kind, the Promotor and/or Organiser will do its utmost in order to solve the situation. A (temporary) solution may also include a manual refuelling of the cars with cans or other at the discretion of the Race Director of the Belcar Endurance Championship.

Any time lost in the refuelling area caused by force majeure will not be compensated.

### **Deposit**

#### **Deposit bracelets**

We kindly ask you to pay a deposit of € 200,00 for the use of 3 orange and 6 green bracelets on account n° BNP Paribas Fortis, IBAN BE84 0018 8149 5559, BIC GEBABEBB of VZW Terlamen.

All teams can return their bracelets at the race secretariat in Zolder during the “American Festival Nascar” after the Belcar race. If the bracelets are returned in good condition, the deposit will be refunded by bank transfer the week after the last race, being 10-16 October 2023.

### **Radio Communication**

At least one month before the start of the meeting, each competitor, team leader, driver, team member or their agents and representatives, desiring to use equipment with radio transmission in order to establish a communication between the car and the team, must file in an application to: B.I.P.T. - Dienst Vergunningen

### **Radio communication from the Race Director**

All teams will get from the promotor of the Belcar a radio which will be used for communication (one way) with the Race Director in addition to messages given on the screen, written or oral. Teams must be listening to the frequency from 15 minutes before the start of each session till the end of the session (free practice, qualifying and race).

### **Podium Ceremony**

May we ask you, if you are among the lucky winners, to stay in the near of the podium so that the ceremony for 1-2-3 can start immediately after the race!

### **Leaving Paddock**

Dismantling is only allowed after the end of the race. Teams who have to dismantle after abandon of the race have to require a permission by the clerk of the course. Breaking this rule will be punished by the organizers.
